

The Maldives' Only Jungle Dining Experience Returns as Nest Reopens at Niyama Private Islands

Niyama Private Islands Maldives reopens its Asian restaurant, Nest, with reimagined jungle dining reinforced with bold, new flavours.

Located within the deep heart of the island of Play, Nest brings dramatic flair to Asian fine dining, with a unique setting of wild, indigenous flora that envelops guests in the surreal and transports them to another world.

The meandering boardwalk through the jungle's overgrown vines under the canopy of a banyan tree decades in the making could be in the deepest of the world's rainforests. On the ground floor, tribal, thatched-roof huts centre around the showcase teppanyaki, where fiery flavours await. Alternatively, guests can ascend the spiral staircase, then cross the bridge to their dining platform suspended six metres in the air. This could be the most unique restaurant in the Indian Ocean.

Nest is open for teppanyaki lunch: 12.00 noon - 2.30 pm, teppanyaki dinner: 4.30 pm - 8.30 pm, and a la carte: 6.30 pm - 10.30 pm.
